FORMAT FOR PLAY

- The format will be a four-person, two best-ball over a two day tournament on the Sun Valley and Elkhorn courses.
- Men - Max handicap of 24 per player.
- Women - Max handicap of 36 per player.
- Each player whose score is counting for the team must putt out.
- Scores and handicaps are subject to review after each round by Handicap Chairman Jeff Petersen, PGA.

PURCHASED MULLIGANS

- Two (2) per day, available for purchase at registration.
- Can be used for any stroke on a hole, excluding contest holes (closest to pin and longest drive).

HANDICAP INDEX

- The handicap index of GHIN for both courses will be based on Sun Valley's course rating. Last year's posted tournament scores may be considered for this year's handicap adjustments by the Handicap Committee. The Committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps at any time during the tournament. The adjusted participant's handicap may be used for individual low net and team scores.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

- Practice rounds for tournament players are available on both courses Wednesday, August 16 and Thursday, August 17 (one on each course per player, two rounds total). Please make tee times in advance. To better accommodate all players please cancel any tee times 48 hours in advance.
